SHOW SITE DIRECTIONS

To get to the Chesterfield County Fairgrounds from I-95, take the **Courthouse Road (Route 651) exit**, head west, and then follow signs to the fairgrounds, usually involving turns onto Jefferson Davis Hwy (Route 1) and then onto the fairgrounds entrance, often using the main entrance on Perry Parkway or nearby roads. It's best to use a GPS or Waze for precise, real-time directions from your exact spot on I-95, but the key is the Courthouse Road exit.

1. **Exit I-95:** Take Exit 64 for Courthouse Road (Route 651).
2. **Head West:** Turn onto Courthouse Road and head west.
3. **Follow Signs:** Continue on Courthouse Road until you see signs for the Fairgrounds or turn onto Jefferson Davis Highway (Route 1) heading south, then follow signs to the Fairgrounds entrance (Perry Parkway area).

The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

VETERAN CLASSES

(Involving Single Dog Entries, to be judged after Winners but before Best of Breed.)

DOGS & BITCHES: Open to any dog/bitch seven (7) years of age or older, on or prior to the day of the show. Note—Chapter 11, Section 8, of the AKC rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides that neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at

•**A RECORDING FEE** of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee will be collected by the Clubs and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (Chapter 11, Sec. 2, AKC Rules).

•**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 10:00 pm , WEDNESDAY • February 25 2026** at the Show Secretary office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Sec. 6 of the AKC Rules. **UNSIGNED ENTRIES FROM EXHIBITORS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY..**

•**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS** and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

•**ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

•**MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to The Capitol Bulldog Club.** CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST MAKE FEES PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS. SHOW SECRETARY assumes NO responsibility for cash sent through the mail. A \$2.00 administrative fee will be charged on all entries cancelled prior to closing.

•**ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, or whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

•**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, no refund will be made if entry has been processed.

•**RETURNED CHECKS & POST-DATED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show ADMINISTRATOR will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a cash basis.

•**ACKNOWLEDGMENT** of entries will be made as soon as is practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the **SHOW SECRETARY.**

•**THERE WILL BE NO SPACE** provided for unentered dogs at this show. The use of private exercise pens is prohibited except in reserved RV area.

•**NOTE:** "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the onsite Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the start of the regular conformation judging at the show (Chapter 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (continued)

•**IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 11, SEC. 11, AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS:** “Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of unentered dogs.” The show-giving clubs will strictly enforce the above-stated rule. Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended. •**THE FAIRGROUNDS & SHOW SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE TO EXHIBITORS** at 3:PM. Thursday, March 12, 2026, at 7:00 AM, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, March 13, 14, and 15, 2026 and until one (1) hour after Best of Breed (all three days).

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OVERNIGHT IN SHOW ROOM & GROOMING AREA.

•**SHOW HOURS:** Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. See show site availability above. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it at ring-side when its classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

•**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary is advised at once. The Secretary, Administrator, and Show-giving clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

•**ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED** the day of the show. Any unclaimed trophies will revert to the general trophy fund after the showing of the breed

•**ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES** except when being judged

LOADING ZONE will be designated near the grooming entrance to show building. Please park in the general parking area once unloading is done.

GROOMING AREA: The Show Building will have designated grooming areas restricted to Exhibitors/Handlers and under control of the Event Committee. No mats or rugs on the floor are allowed. A limited number of electrical outlets area available. Crate tags are encouraged. Stacking may be enforced as necessary.

•**GROOMING** dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced.

NO CRATING OR GROOMING will be allowed near conformation ring.

A **PRE-RING WAITING AREA** will be established near the ring entrance. Only dogs and handlers in the next immediate class are allowed in this area.

FOOD/DRINK: Not provided except during hospitality. There are numerous eating places within a reasonable distance of the fairgrounds. **NO ALCOHOLIC** beverages are allowed in the show building.

•**NO DOGS OR FEED BOWLS ALLOWED** in restrooms. Persons found violating this rule are subject to action by the Event Committee.

NO SMOKING is allowed in any of the Fairgrounds buildings. Smokers, please use the ash cans located outside the show building to extinguish your cigarettes.

TRASH RECEPTACLES and potable water will be available in the show area.

•**HANDICAPPED FACILITIES** are available.

•**PLEASE OBEY** all posted signs. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HELP** to maintain this site by assisting in keeping it in excellent condition.

•**ALL EXHIBITORS ARE CHARGED** with the responsibility of cleaning in and around their vehicles, crates, and dogs. Please clean up after your dog(s) immediately. Please dispose of all garbage in proper containers.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
